### Summary

This classification performs the safe and legal management of noxious weeds and undesirable vegetation using a variety of management techniques on private, county, and other public lands.

### Examples of Essential Job Duties:

- Mix and apply pesticides and herbicides in accordance to Pesticide Labels and record or log all sprayed areas in accordance with State statutes and department policies. Review chemical labels and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for each product before application. Calculate mix ratios and compute how much spray is necessary for a given area.
- Perform chemical application operations using a broad range of equipment and methods according to applicable laws.
- Operate vehicles and application delivery systems including a spray truck, four-wheelers, boats, four-wheel drive pickups, backpack and other weed control equipment. Adhere to safety standards including observing weather conditions, traffic, water and animals that may affect spraying operations. May be required to pull and back-up trailers in adverse weather conditions.

### Education, Experience and Training

At time of appointment, must possess and have the ability to maintain a valid Oregon driver's license. One (1) year previous weed spraying experience preferred. One year of ArcMap GIS experience or two years professional GPS use a plus. Must be able to obtain an Oregon Department of Agriculture Public Pesticide Applicator's License with a Right-of-Way and Regulatory Weed endorsements, and an Oregon Boater Education Card within 30 days of employment.
